CALL FOR POSTER AND TOOL DEMONSTRATIONS (FORUM)

The CAiSE'08 Forum is a place for presenting and discussing ideas, concepts, experiments gained in developing Information Systems (IS), emerging new topics, controversial positions, as well as a place for demonstrating new systems, tools and applications. Results of innovative projects and prototypes as well as new approaches can be submitted either as short papers, or as experiment reports, as well.

Topics of interest include, but are not restricted to:

- IS development for sustainability IS
- IS development with ubiquitous technologies
- IT requirements for SIS development
- Cognitive, business, social and requirement models for SIS
- Secure & trusted SIS
- IS compliance with rules, regulations or laws
- IS evolution at any level: goals, requirements, models, systems Database support for SIS
- Conformance of the various IS levels: process, static, requirement, use case
- Adequacy of IS development and enterprise development
- Networked & virtual organizations
- Participatory, collaborative IS approaches

The conference also welcomes papers on the fundamental aspects of IS engineering.

- Enterprise architecture and enterprise modelling
- Requirements engineering for IS
- Knowledge patterns relevant to IS engineering (ISE)
- Ontology for ISE
- Business process modelling and management
- IS Component-based development
- Interoperability of IS and enterprises
- Semantic web, Web 2.0
- Components of methods, chunks, fragments
- Constellation of values, intentions, requirements
- Formal IS aspects

Submission

We solicit results of innovative projects and prototypes as well as promising new approaches, and experience reports as short papers. They will be included in the special proceedings issue entitled “CAiSE Forum”, which will be formally published by CEUR. In addition, the CAiSE Forum will be published electronically and will be included in the DBLP indexing services for rapid and extensive dissemination.

Short papers must not exceed 4 pages and have to conform to the LNCS style (see <http://www.springer.de/comp/lncs/authors.html> for further details). All the submitted materials should not fall under any kind of rights or other unlawful matter.

Authors should submit their short papers electronically in PDF format, under their final form to the forum chairs: [Carson Woo](#) and [Ela Hunt](#).

Presentation and Publication

It is expected that one of the authors presents the short paper and participates at the forum discussions. Indeed, the CAiSE forum being intended for intensive discussion, the papers are to be shortly presented and large room is to be left for exchange of positions and ideas among the authors and the audience. The presentation will be possible as a poster and/or demo. Presentation possibilities and details will be announced in due time (with the acceptance of the Forum contribution).
